

Fall Tech Questions For Customers

- What are you using now?
- Do you have any of the ABC's of Fall Protection? (Anchor point, body harness, connecting device)
- Does your harness need to be one DRing or 3 Dring? (1 DRing=fall protection, 3 DRing=fall protection and positioning.
- Do you prefer tongue and buckle or mating buckle adjustments to your harness? (Tongue and buckle is easier to adjust; mating buckle is if you only have one user--easiest to adjust and stay adjusted to your body.
- Does your lanyard need to be 100% tie off or just a single leg? (100% Tie off is dual leg lanyard, single leg is adequate but not as good.
- What sizes locking snap hooks are required on your lanyard (standard, pelican, or carabiners)
- What are you anchoring to, does it have a 5,000 lb rating? (Do you need a cross arm strap, or a removable roof anchor?)
- Will one person be anchoring to the anchor point or will there be more? (Only 5,000 lbs per person of force per anchor point. 2 people=10,000 lbs of support)
- Do you need any retractable lifelines or confined space entry equipment?
- Do you need any rope or rope grabs?
